### Description

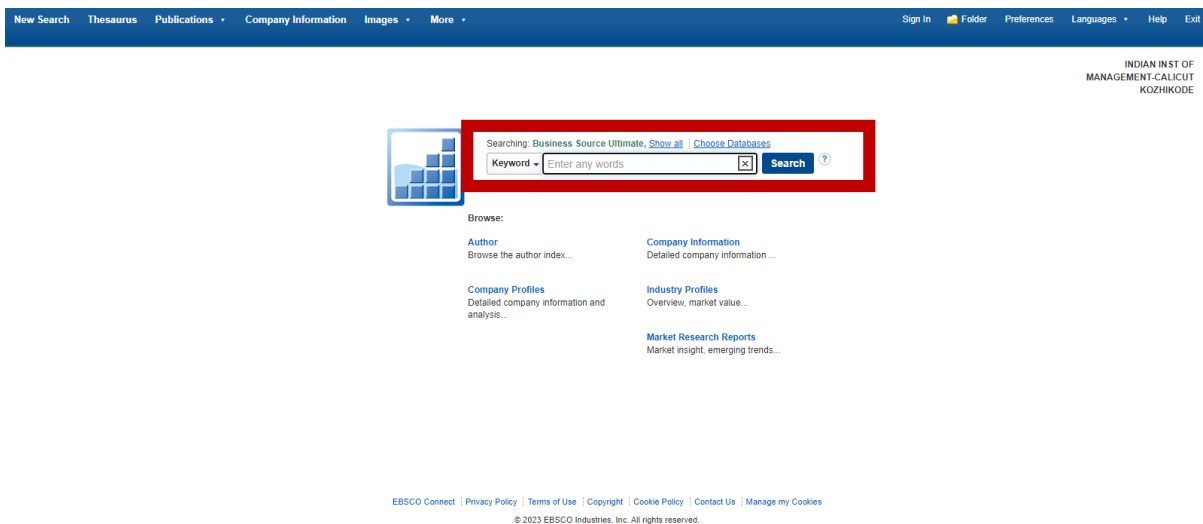

**Major Subject Areas Covered:** Company Information; Company Profiles; Industry Profiles; Market Research Reports

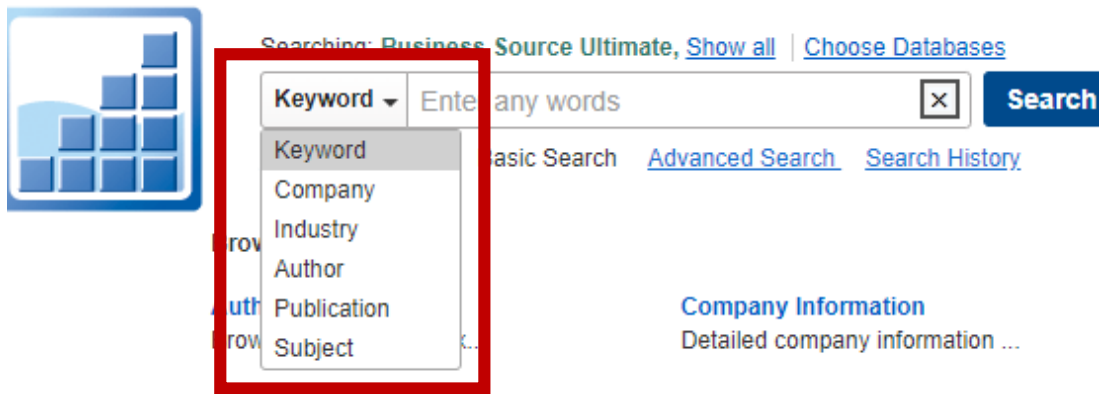

### How to use:

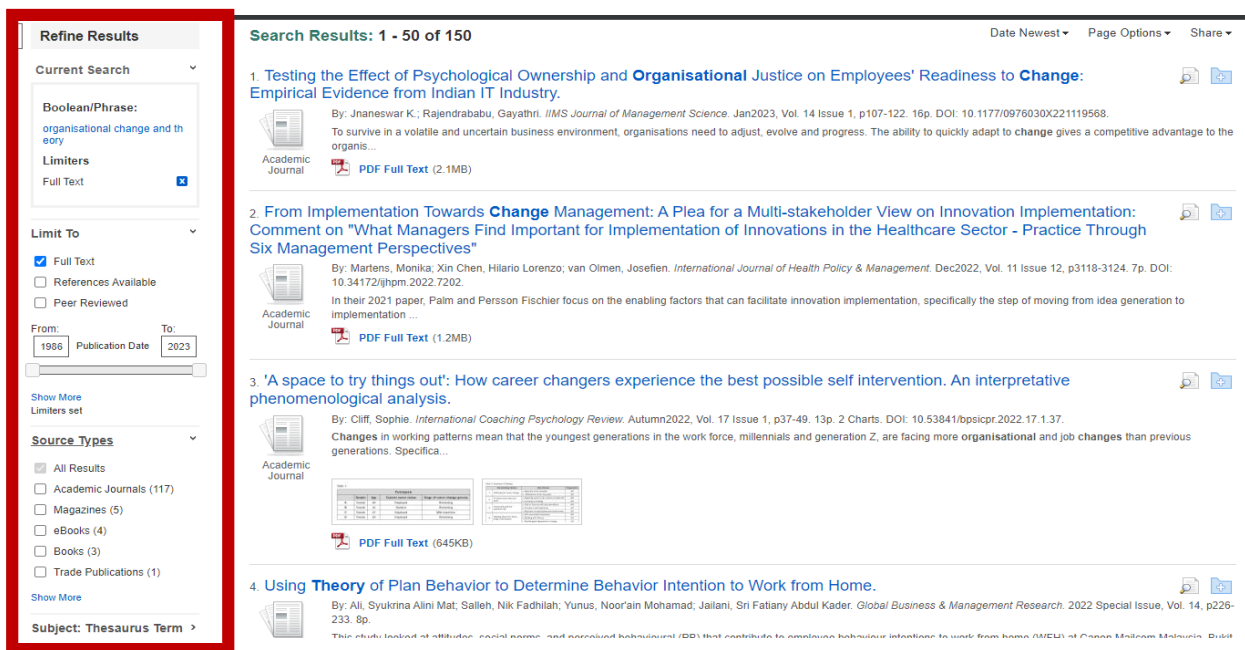
- 1) Basic Search: Enter the search terms in the box. Instead of inputting entire sentences or inquiries, list the key terms that best represent your search.



You can also use the drop down field to best represent you input.



To narrow down your search by parameters like date range, source type, or language, use the filters on the results page. If you're solely looking for magazine articles, company profiles, academic articles, etc., the source type option is really helpful.



2) Advanced Search:

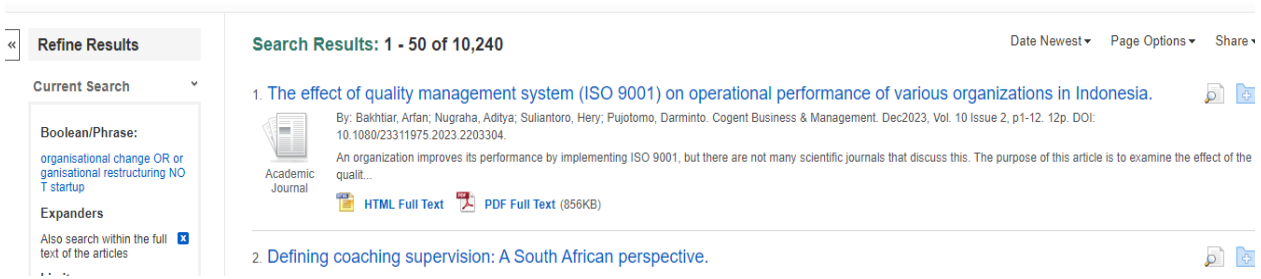
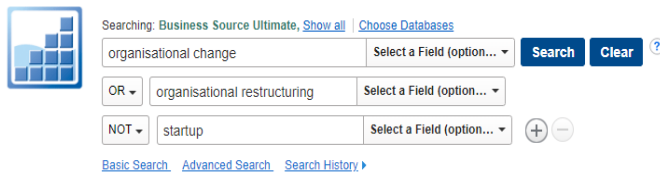
To make sure your terms appear together, enclose them in quotation marks. This is a fast method of limiting your search results.

AND - Articles containing both of your search terms—"organisational change" AND theory—are found using the AND function. Make use of this to connect disparate concepts and focus your search.

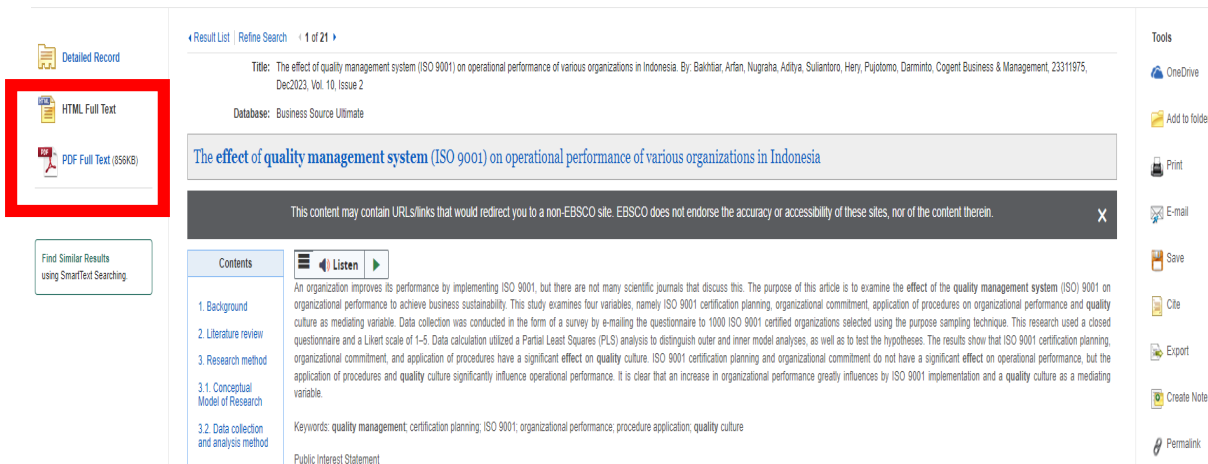
OR - "Organisational change" OR "organisational restructuring" are the search phrases that yield articles that contain either of these terms. This can be used to find more results by connecting terms that have similar meanings.

NOT: The operator eliminates all articles containing your second word, "organisational change" NOT startup.


'Truncating', or abbreviating, a word with a \* will return all terms that begin with the same letter; for example, leader\* will return leader, leaders, leadership, and leading.



3) You can access the articles in HTML and PDF formats.




## 4) You may add the articles into folders, save, e-mail & print them and create notes.


