Access Method: IP Authentication + No Registration


How to use:

- 1) Search: You can begin searching from the right side of the screen.






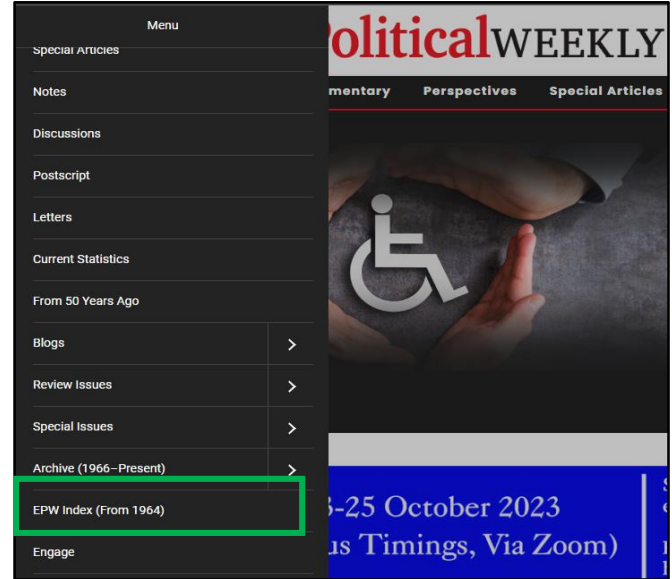
