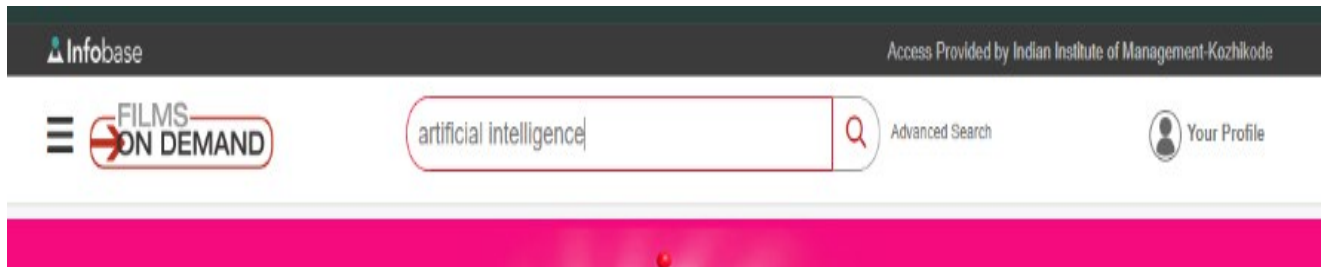

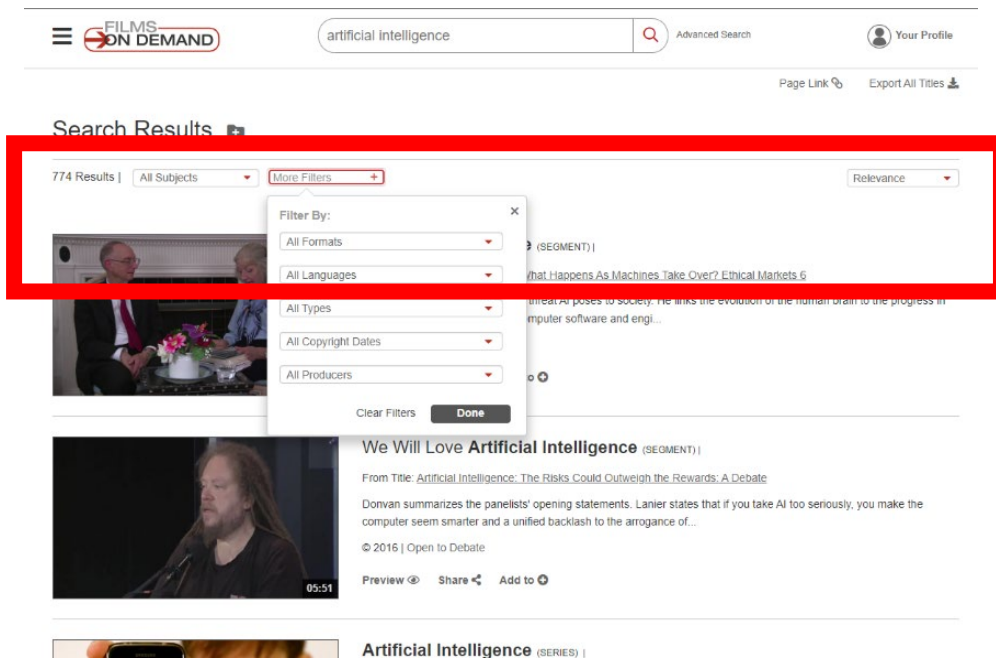

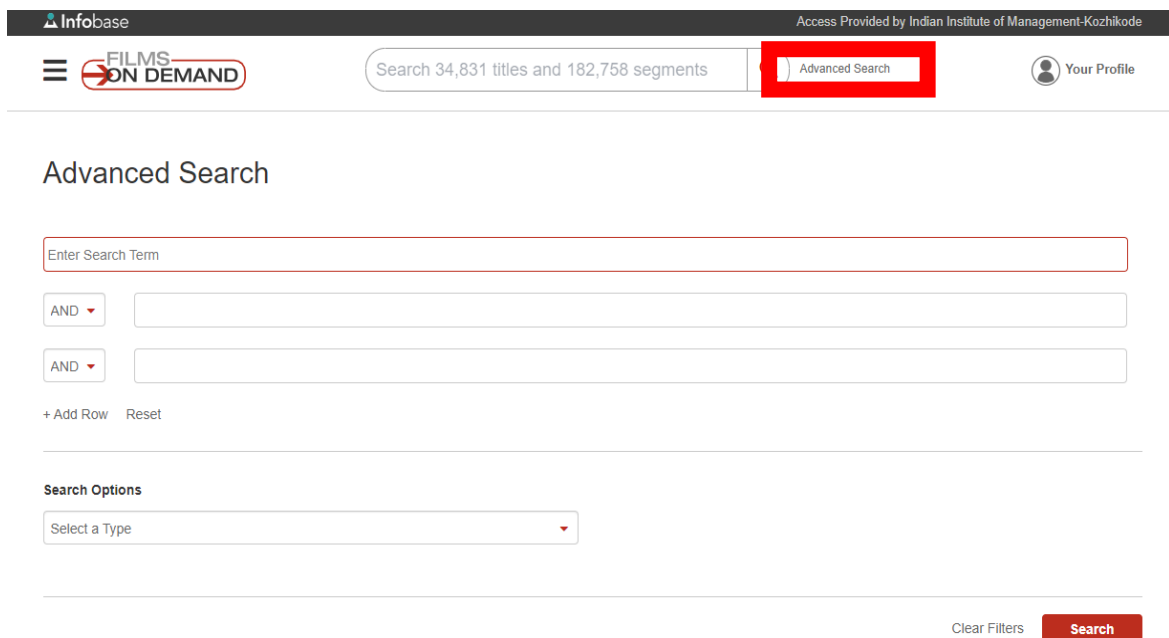
How to use:

- 2) With Advanced Search, you may refine your results by producer, language, copyright, topic, closed captioning, and other factors before starting your search. You can also use the AND, OR, and NOT Boolean operators.



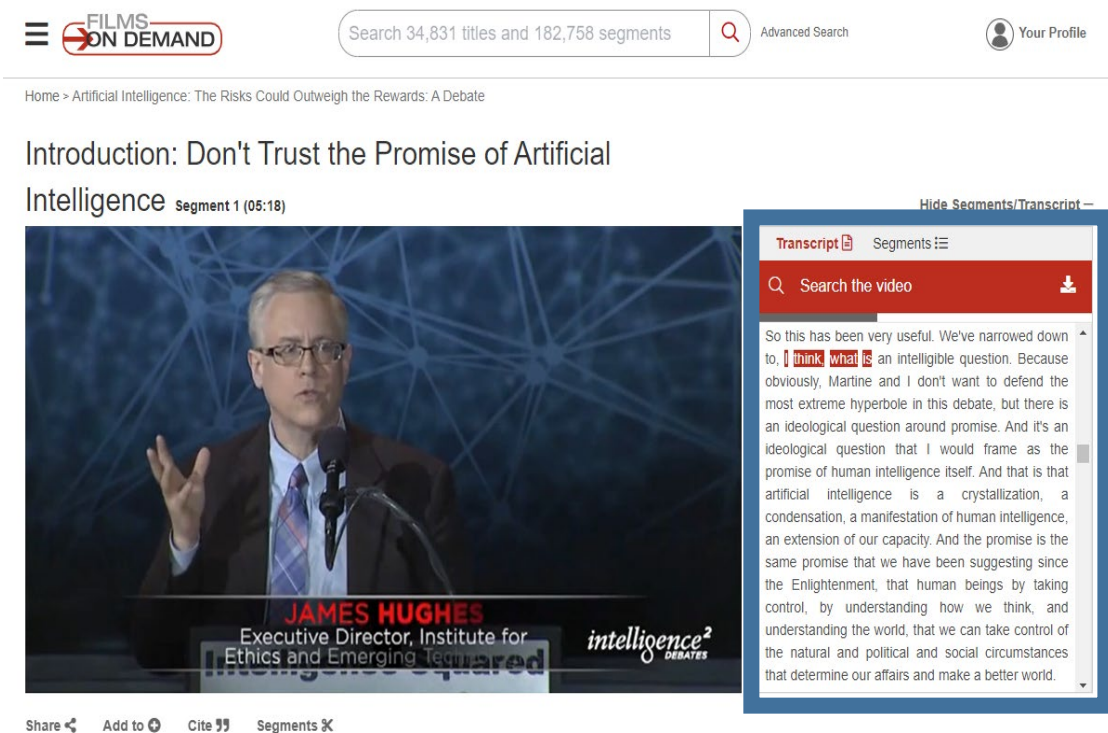
- For a direct link to your search results, use the Page Link option.
 To get an Excel sheet of every title found in your search, choose Export All Titles.
 You may then arrange the titles anyway you see fit.

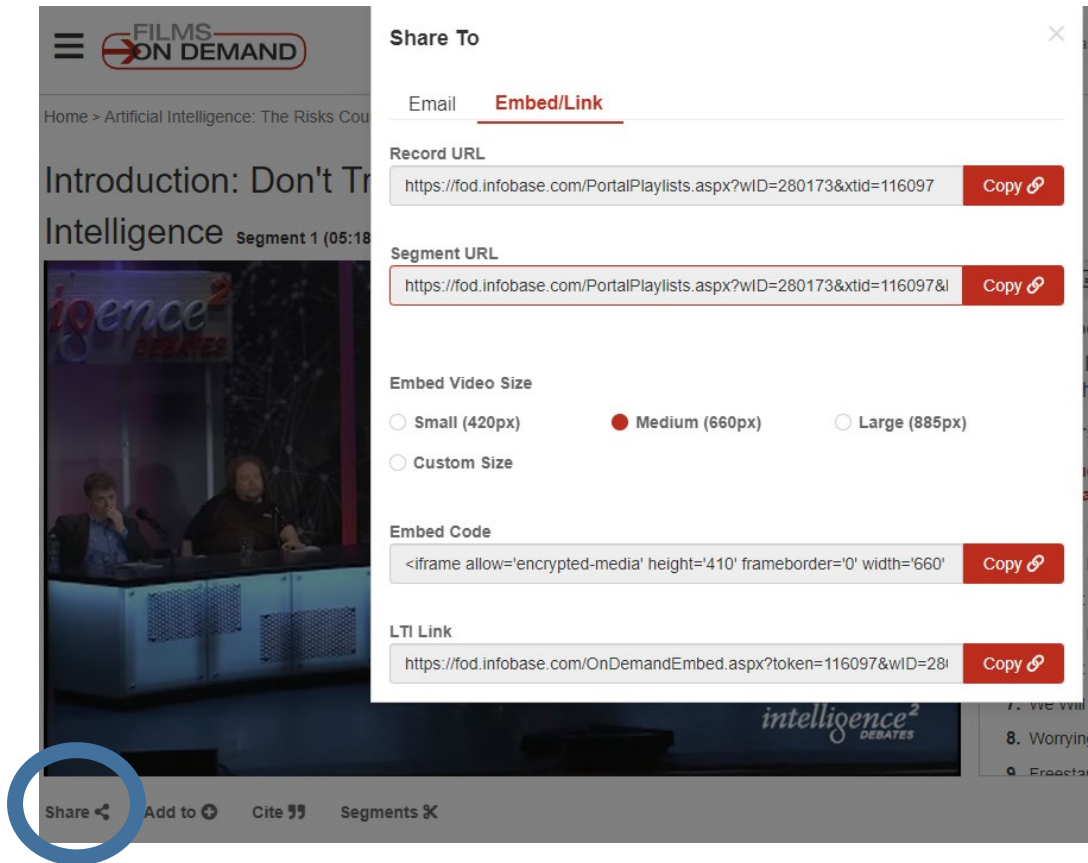

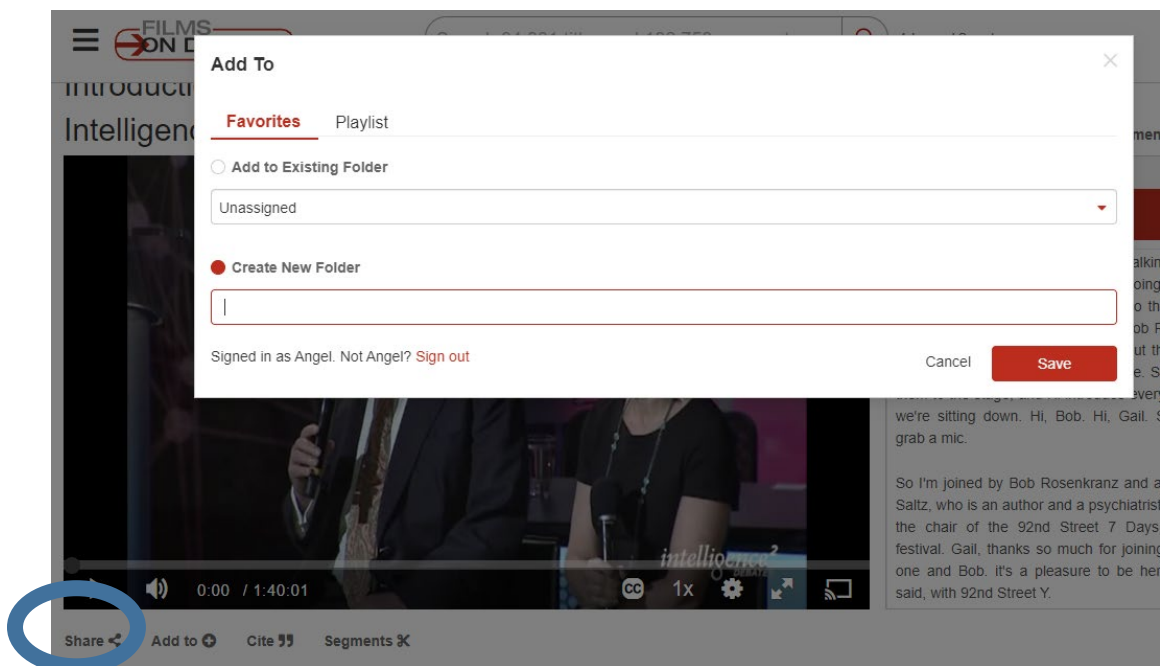


