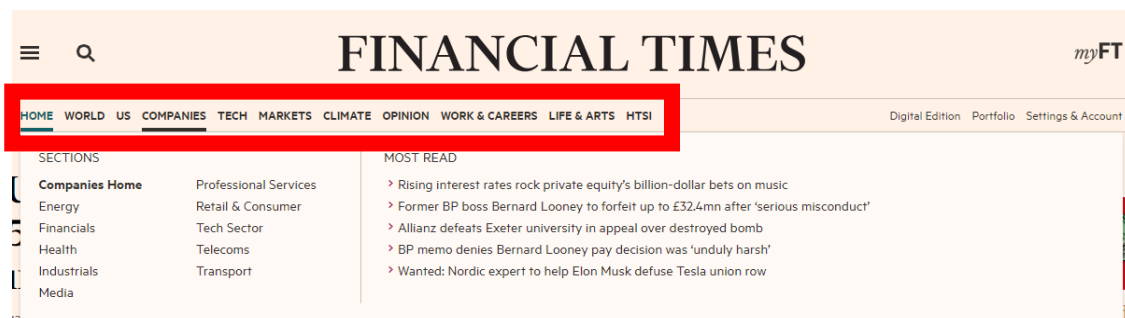

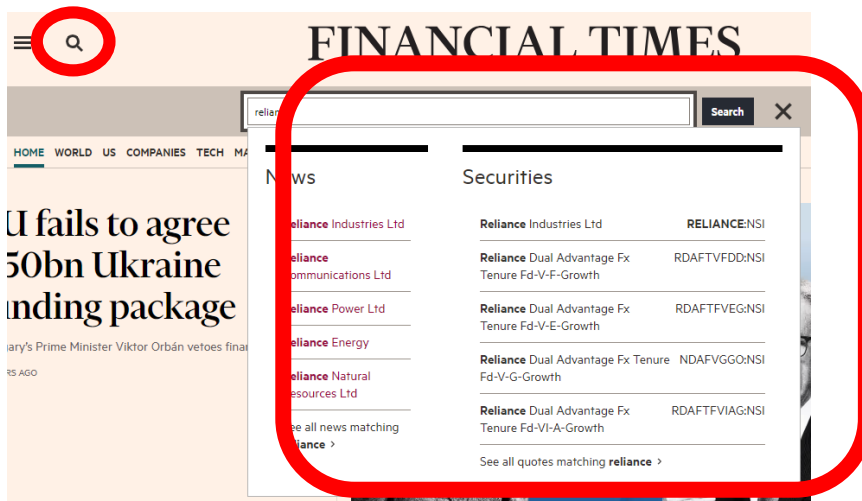

### How to use:

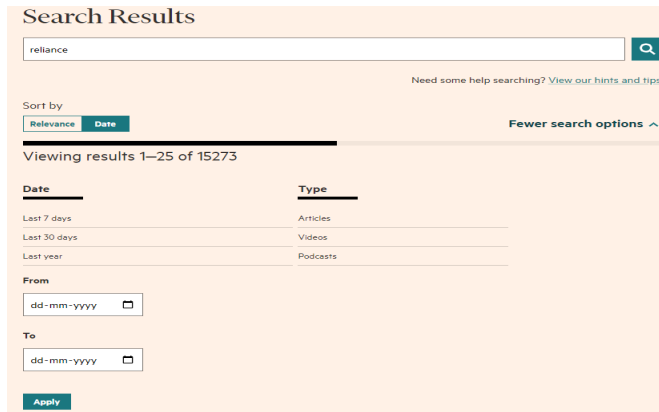
- 1) Browse through content on companies, technology, arts, etc. from the bar on the top.



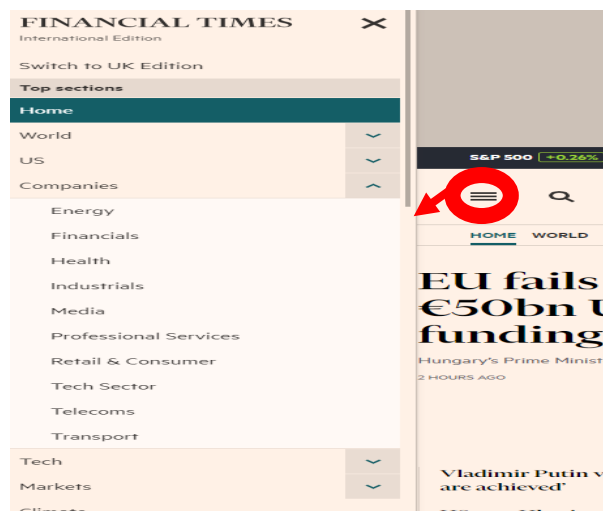
2) Search for topics, news and keywords.



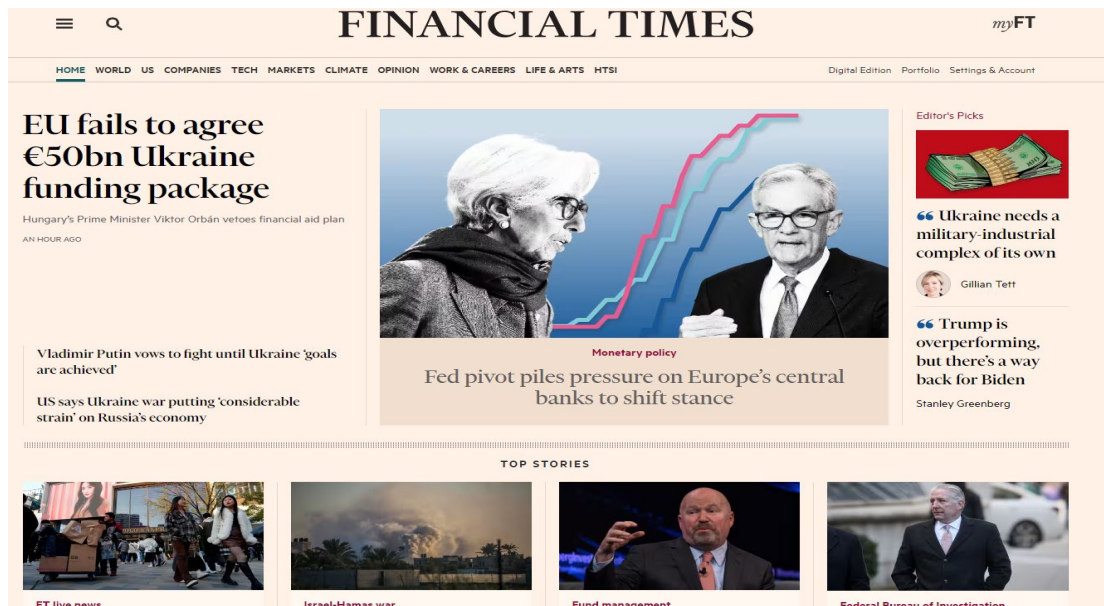
Filter your search based on date, type of document, etc.



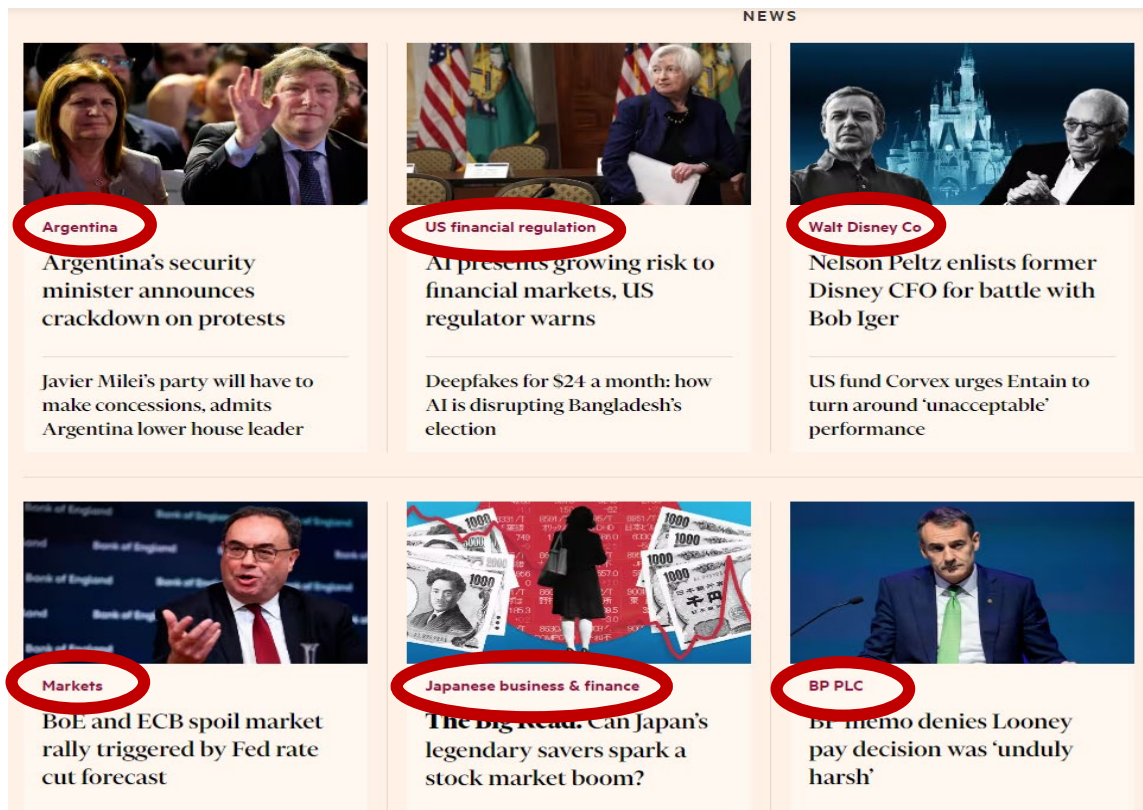
3) You can click the three lines as well to browse through specific fields.



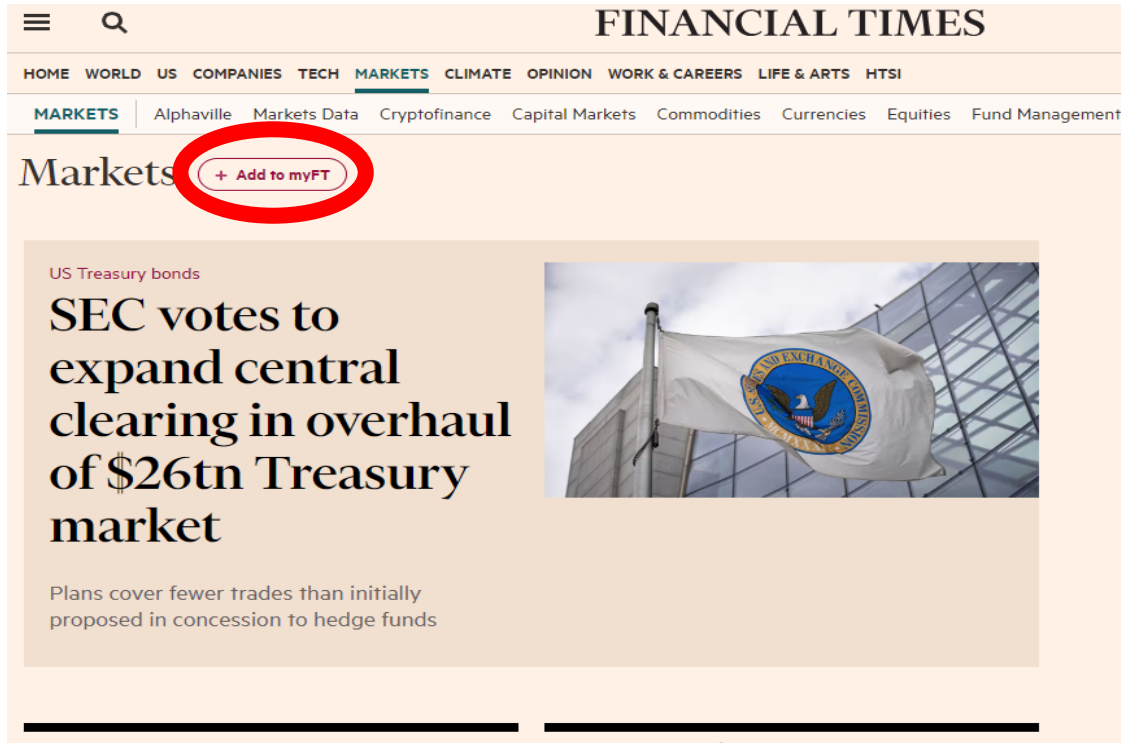
- 4) Every story on FT.com has a topic associated with it to make it easier for you to find relevant and fresh material.



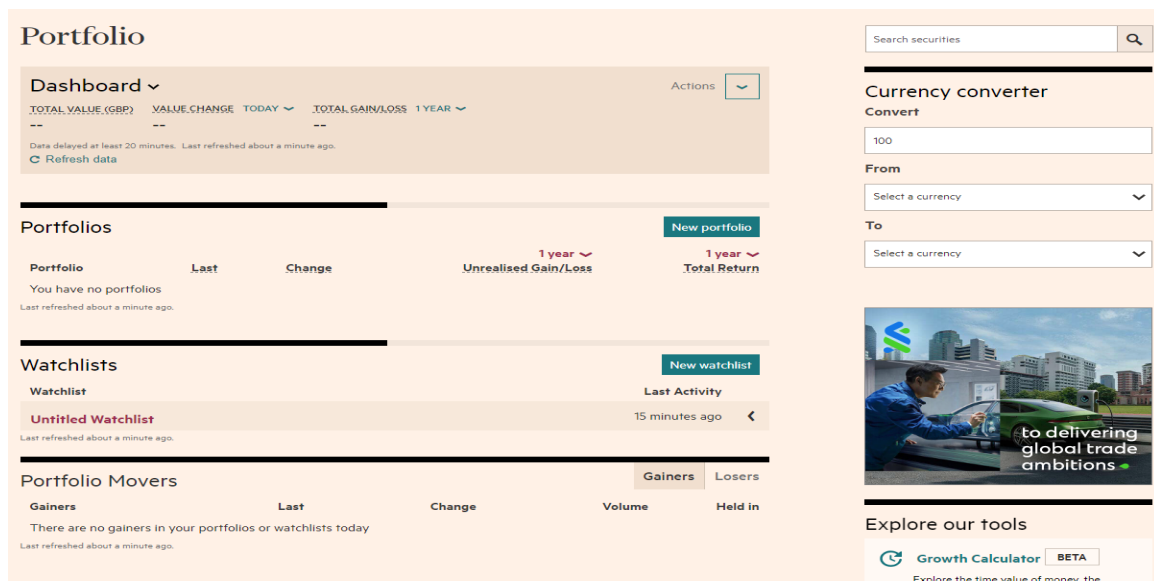
Select topics to see other articles on that subject. Additionally, you may browse the FT.com and journalist fields.
