

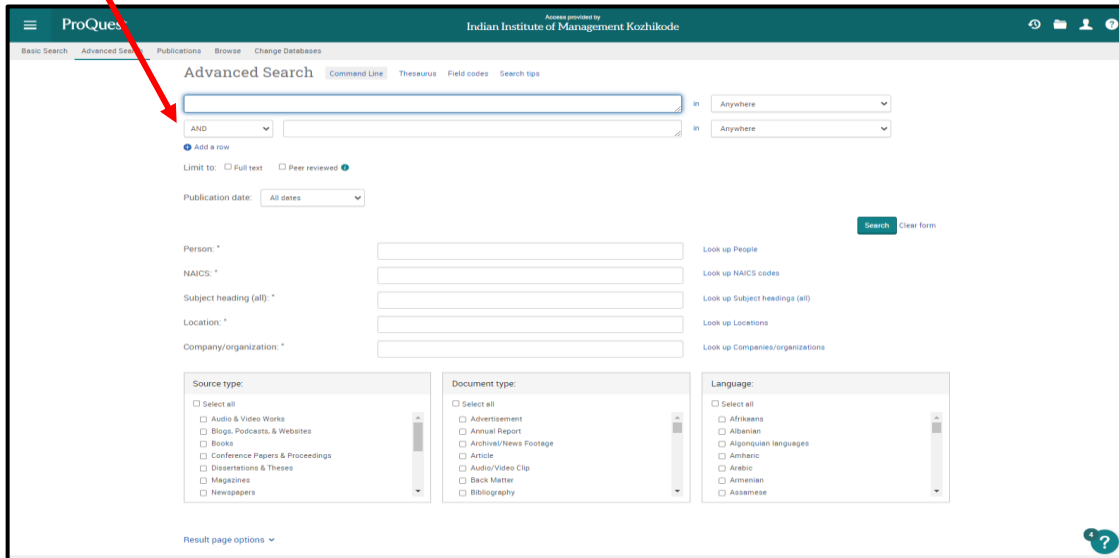
**How to use:**
